

**DAYS ONE & TWO****Genesis 4:5, 6**

- 5 but for Cain and for his offering He had no regard. So Cain became very angry and his countenance fell.
- 6 Then the LORD said to Cain, “Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen?”

**Genesis 18:30-32**

- 30 Then he said, “Oh may the Lord not be angry, and I shall speak; suppose thirty are found there?” And He said, “I will not do *it* if I find thirty there.”
- 31 And he said, “Now behold, I have ventured to speak to the Lord; suppose twenty are found there?” And He said, “I will not destroy *it* on account of the twenty.”
- 32 Then he said, “Oh may the Lord not be angry, and I shall speak only this once; suppose ten are found there?” And He said, “I will not destroy *it* on account of the ten.”

**Hebrews 12:14-17**

- 14 Pursue peace with all men, and the sanctification without which no one will see the Lord.
- 15 See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble, and by it many be defiled;
- 16 that *there be* no immoral or godless person like Esau, who sold his own birthright for a *single* meal.
- 17 For you know that even afterwards, when he desired to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no place for repentance, though he sought for it with tears.

**Ephesians 4:25:32**

- 25 Therefore, laying aside falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH EACH ONE *of you* WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, for we are members of one another.
- 26 BE ANGRY, AND *yet* DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger,
- 27 and do not give the devil an opportunity.
- 28 He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have *something* to share with one who has need.
- 29 Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such *a word* as is good for edification according to the need *of the moment*, so that it will give grace to those who hear.
- 30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
- 31 Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.
- 32 Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

**DAY THREE****Genesis 14:17-20**

- 17 Then after his return from the defeat of Chedorlaomer and the kings who were with him, the king of Sodom went out to meet him at the valley of Shaveh (that is, the King’s Valley).
- 18 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; now he was a priest of God Most High.
- 19 He blessed him and said,

20           “Blessed be Abram of God Most High,  
          Possessor of heaven and earth;  
          And blessed be God Most High,  
          Who has delivered your enemies into your hand.”  
          He gave him a tenth of all.

### **Leviticus 27:30-32**

30    ‘Thus all the tithe of the land, of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD’S; it is holy to the LORD.  
31    ‘If, therefore, a man wishes to redeem part of his tithe, he shall add to it one-fifth of it.  
32    ‘For every tenth part of herd or flock, whatever passes under the rod, the tenth one shall be holy to the LORD.

### **DAY FOUR**

#### **Genesis 20:17-18**

17    Abraham prayed to God, and God healed Abimelech and his wife and his maids, so that they bore *children*.  
18    For the LORD had closed fast all the wombs of the household of Abimelech because of Sarah, Abraham’s wife.

#### **Luke 1:7, 25**

7    But they had no child, because Elizabeth was barren, and they were both advanced in years.  
  
25    “‘This is the way the Lord has dealt with me in the days when He looked *with favor* upon *me*, to take away my disgrace among men.”

#### **1 Samuel 1:5-6, 9-11, 19-20;**

5    but to Hannah he would give a double portion, for he loved Hannah, but the LORD had closed her womb.  
6    Her rival, however, would provoke her bitterly to irritate her, because the LORD had closed her womb.  
  
9    Then Hannah rose after eating and drinking in Shiloh. Now Eli the priest was sitting on the seat by the doorpost of the temple of the LORD.  
10   She, greatly distressed, prayed to the LORD and wept bitterly.  
11   She made a vow and said, “O LORD of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a son, then I will give him to the LORD all the days of his life, and a razor shall never come on his head.”

#### **1 Samuel 2:6**

6    “The LORD kills and makes alive;  
          He brings down to Sheol and raises up.

#### **Psalms 139:13-16**

13    For You formed my inward parts;  
          You wove me in my mother’s womb.  
14    I will give thanks to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made;  
          Wonderful are Your works,  
          And my soul knows it very well.

15 My frame was not hidden from You,  
When I was made in secret,  
*And* skillfully wrought in the depths of the earth;  
16 Your eyes have seen my unformed substance;  
And in Your book were all written  
The days that were ordained *for me*,  
When as yet there was not one of them.

## **DAY FIVE**

### **Hebrews 1:1-2**

1 God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways,  
2 in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

### **Genesis 16:7, 9-11**

7 Now the angel of the LORD found her by a spring of water in the wilderness, by the spring on the way to Shur.  
  
9 Then the angel of the LORD said to her, “Return to your mistress, and submit yourself to her authority.”  
10 Moreover, the angel of the LORD said to her, “I will greatly multiply your descendants so that they will be too many to count.”  
11 The angel of the LORD said to her further,  
“Behold, you are with child,  
And you will bear a son;  
And you shall call his name Ishmael,  
Because the LORD has given heed to your affliction.

### **Genesis 22:11, 15**

11 But the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, “Abraham, Abraham!”  
And he said, “Here I am.”  
12 He said, “Do not stretch out your hand against the lad, and do nothing to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me.”  
  
15 Then the angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time from heaven,  
16 and said, “By Myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have done this thing and have not withheld your son, your only son,  
17 indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies.  
18 “In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.”
